- List of publications (if applicable)
- Initial research plan (max 4 pages)

The attachments must be written in English, Finnish or Swedish.

Attachments required from applicants who are not existing members of the ACCC Doctoral Programme **and** have obtained their MSc degree outside the ACCC university units:

- Scanned copy of MSc certificate
- Scanned copy of transcript of records including all passed course units, their completion date and the grades and credits awarded
- Motivation letter (1 page)

If the above mentioned documents are not written in English, Finnish or Swedish, translation to one of these languages must be included.

The ACCC Steering Committee may contact the supervisor for a statement of MSc/PhD studies.
