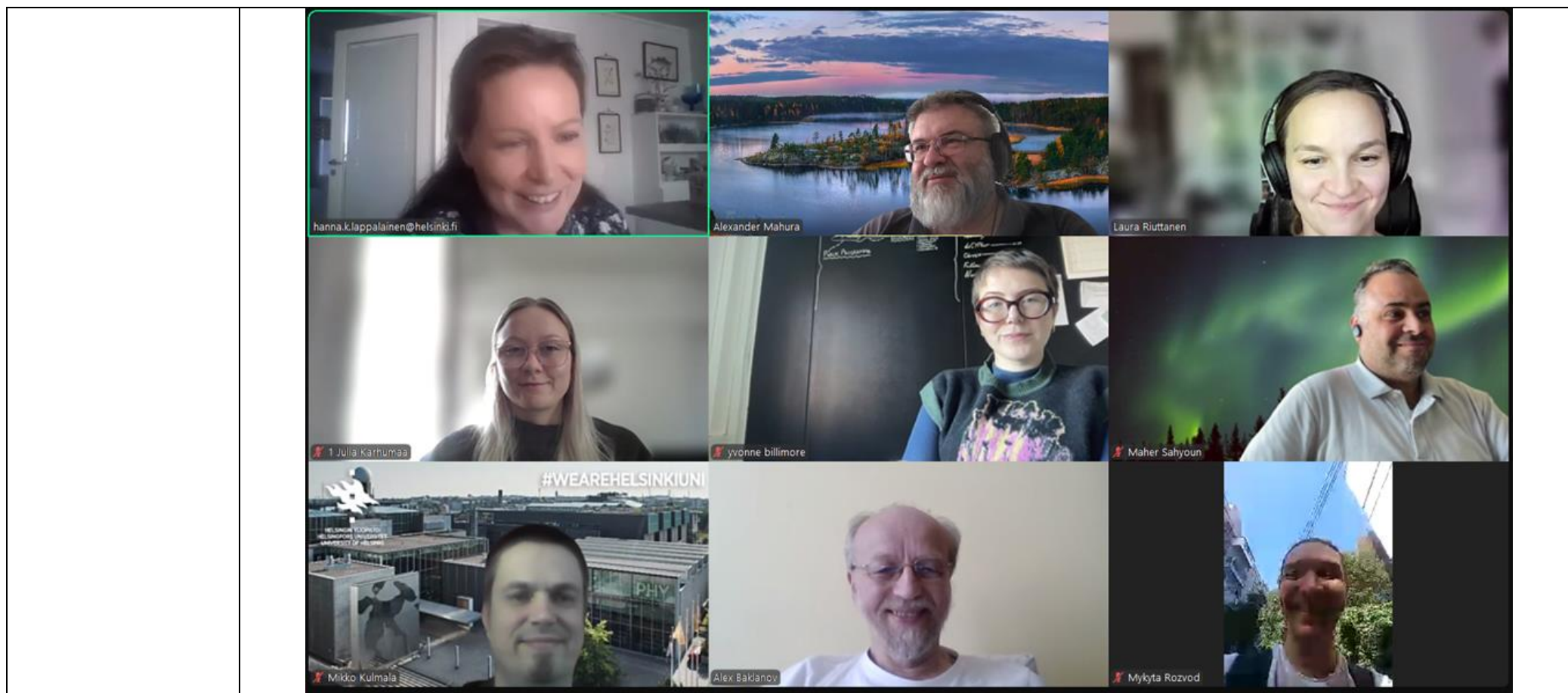

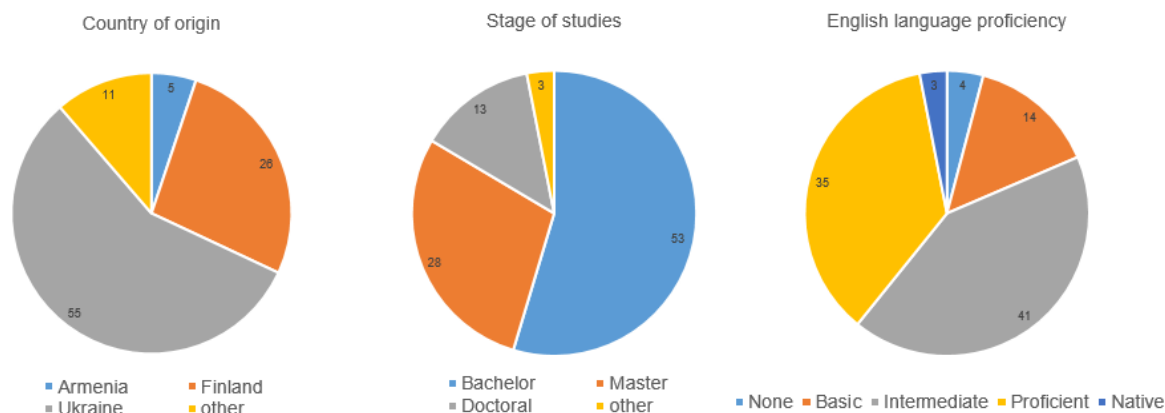

- Comments of moderator from UCPH team:
 - The presentations on the first day have to be better prepared. The speakers were underwhelming: (1) No reading off a paper, never. Show some emotions and make it a presentation that is worth listening to; (2) Go through the presentations with the speakers beforehand, give honest feedback and improve presentations. If necessary, offer them help to give good presentations; (3) Speak with a microphone (from a headset or different), not on a loudspeaker. Definitely in a quiet place; (4) No effects on the slides (videos, gifs, ...), it just does not work over zoom.
 - The zoom chat was very difficult to operate, every time I was looking at a response from a comment and someone would send a message, the whole chat shifted and I had to search where I was reading.
 - On the first day there were supposed to be 7 students, only 3 showed up, of which two never attended again: (1) There has to be some accountability for the students to show up and participate; (2) As a moderator, I have no way of encouraging the students to talk in the group. If they do not say anything all week but hand in a report, they will get the ECTS.
 - The English requirements have to be enforced. Some students would not speak at all
 - I am not sure if it is a good idea to have 1h presentation and then 2h group, maybe split it up into changing more often between groups and presentation (just an idea, I don't know if that would work)

It was agreed that next **2nd VE Week will take place 12-16 MAY 2025, 14 pm + 3h (Helsinki time)**

Discussion:

- **YSU (Karen Ghazaryan): starting at 15:00, Yerevan time and at the beginning of May, i.e. from May 5-9, 2025**
- *We would like to especially emphasize that the first virtual week, in our opinion, was quite successful and interesting. Nevertheless, despite the fact that 39 students were registered from Armenia, most of them were not able to participate in the activities of the virtual week due to the fact that the lectures and discussions of the virtual week overlapped with their lectures. We also note that this period was inconvenient for the teachers as well. We will be very grateful if the next virtual week is organized starting at 15:00, Yerevan time and at the beginning of May, i.e. from May 5-9, 2025. In addition, since our students were very willing to participate in the activities of the virtual week, but not all of them were fluent in English, it would be a good idea to include at least a few students from Armenia in the same break-out group in the future, so that the students support each other and the discussions are more effective (fully understanding and supporting your intention to create international groups).*
- *We would like to note that there were some organizational slips, as some of our moderators for some reason were sent to break-out groups as students and when trying to somehow resolve this issue by contacting the organizers, they never received an answer. We are fully aware that holding such an event is associated with certain difficulties and we hope that with joint efforts we will achieve an excellent result.*
- **TSNUK (Olga Shevchenko): 12-16 May 2025. Time does not matter as students in different courses study at different times.**
- *During the VE week in October, we had the same problem as our colleagues from Yerevan State University - the activities during the VE week overlapped with the university lectures. However, we resolved this issue - students who participated in the VE week were allowed to take tasks from lectures and complete the tasks on their own in the disciplines they missed. The teachers involved as moderators were allowed to reschedule classes for another time in agreement with the students and the dean's office. I think we will follow the same practice during the next week of virtual exchange. Because it is very difficult to choose the dates and times which would be ideal for everyone - both students of different courses and our teachers, so that no one misses their classes.*
- *To be ready to discuss VE week at the next monthly meeting, tomorrow I have a meeting with all the moderators from TSNUK to get their feedback on the virtual exchange week.*

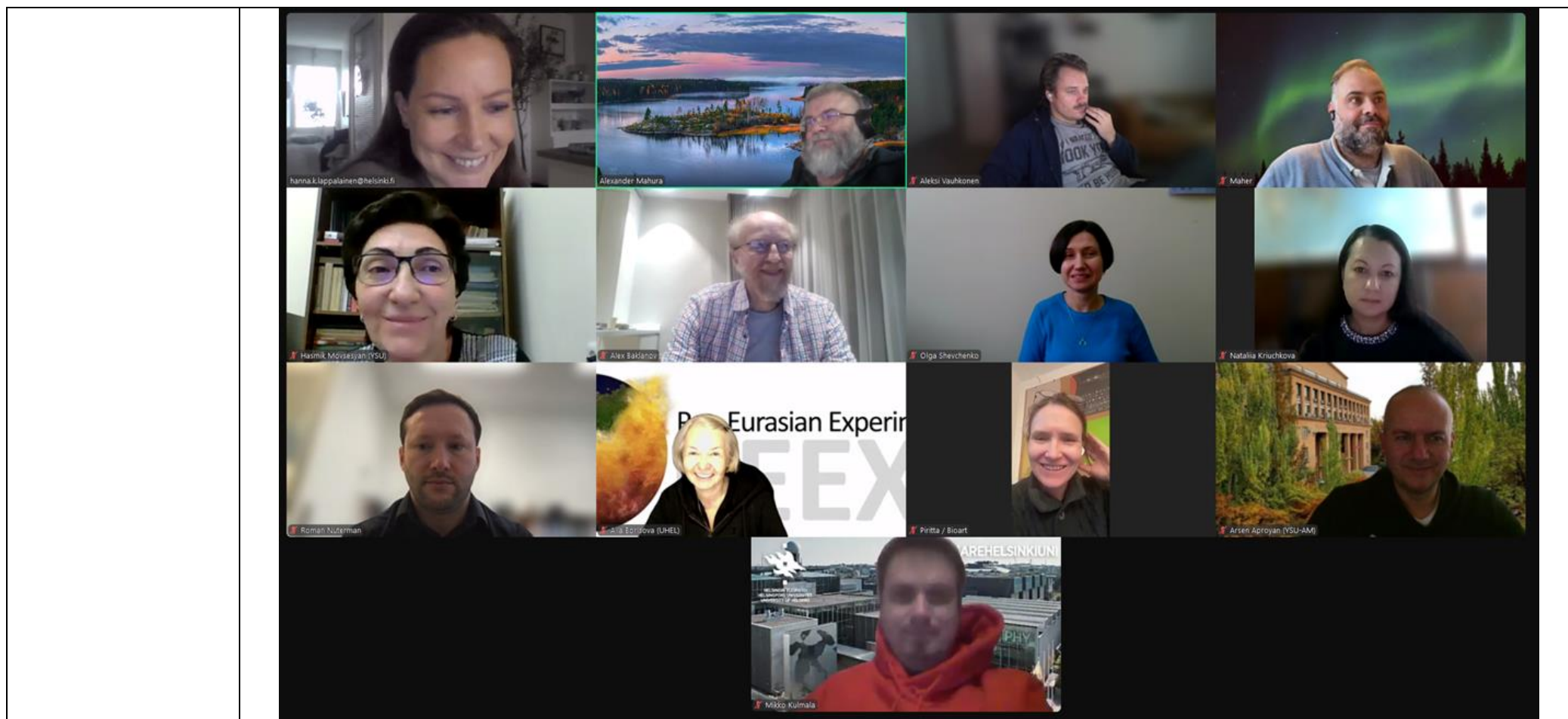

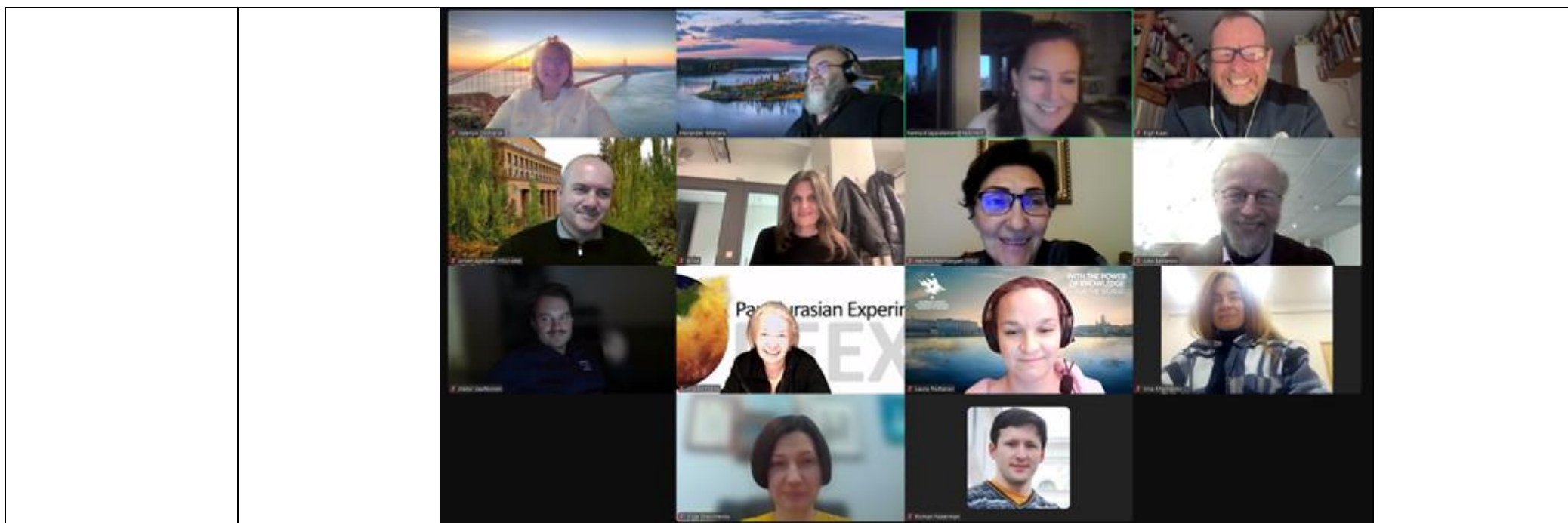
