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Design, organization and installation of a webpage to announce Arctic field campaigns and reorganize logistical challenges within the scientific Arctic community

A new website has been created where details about planned intensive field campaigns in polar areas should be given. These details include location and period of the campaign, measured parameters and instrumentation and some more information. The design of the website was improved during the first year of the project and will still be modified according to the feedback of users. A doc – form can be downloaded from the project webpage (<https://www.atm.helsinki.fi/icupe/>), filled, and submitted to the management team. The collection of campaigns should include all kind of measurements, ground-based, as well as airborne intensive campaigns, those measuring near surface, but also vertical profiling. Observed parameters may cover all kind of aerosol parameters, trace gases, and related measurements. Interested scientists may contact the responsible person and establish cooperation and collaboration.

The form asks for the following details of the campaign:

- Short abstract, Keywords, Scientific question, Location, Campaign start and end dates
- Type of measurements: Ground-based in-situ, Ground-based remote sensing, Airborne in-situ or Airborne remote sensing

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- Measured parameters: Aerosols, Gases, Clouds or Others (what) and details related to these measurements
- Part of a bigger project / activity / infrastructure? If yes, which one?
- Participating institutes
- Is additional participation possible? Wishes?
