The Alliance was founded to sustain the dynamic brought to EU science diplomacy by three research projects that were funded by the European Commission (Horizon 2020).

The Coordinators of S4D4C, InsSciDE and EL-CSID together launched the Alliance at the Final Networking Conference of S4D4C on 19 March 2021, with the support of 14 founding members and adopted the founding document at the first General Assembly on 10 June 2021.

Science diplomacy is the interaction space where science, science policy, and foreign policy meet. When launching the Alliance, we were aiming to connect and nurture the science diplomacy communities, support information exchange, and build capacities. Our Structure

The Alliance serves as a hub for cooperative activities and voluntary coordination and relies upon the participating membership community and networks to highlight and select different areas and innovative activities to be pursued.

There are currently two member options: regular Members and Global Networking Partners. Members are legal entities based in the EU. Global Networking Partners are either based outside the EU or have a geographical focus that lies outside.

The Alliance currently consists of 32 organisations and has two Advisory Partners who are involved upon invitation. We are growing and open to new members!
