Arctic Urbanization under Environmental Change Workshop on 14-15 January 2020 in University of Helsinki, Finland.

This workshop aimed to gather research questions on Arctic urbanization under environmental and climate change undertaken from the social science, humanities and natural sciences perspectives with a particular focus on potential work in Nadym and Salekhard, Russia, and Tromsö, Norway, and any other city of interest. The idea is to build on efforts from Fairbanks and establish a series of studies around the Arctic in cities that represent different environments and conditions.
