

- Interaction: ongoing with frequent and deep engagement
- <u>Tech-supported</u>: utilizing modern media/technologies with real-time meetings using interactive platforms (like Zoom)
- Interpersonal: promoting dialogue across cultures and positive action for lasting relationships
- Learner-driven: participants take the lead in knowledge exchange and creation through dialogue, drawing from personal experiences
- Moderated: guided by trained moderators / educators
- <u>Educational</u>: integrated into formal / informal learning to enhance skills, knowledge, and attitudes fostering positive behaviors
- **Promotes mutual understanding**: covering topics such as identity, empathy, and critical reflection to enable conversations amidst cultural differences




Online Learning - the Future of Education ?



- Concept of traditional education is chancing (COVID-19 !)
- Being physically present in a classroom isn't the only learning option anymore — not with the rise of the internet and new technologies, at least.
- Online learning access to a quality education whenever and wherever you want, as long as you can get online
- Challenges of distance learning can be little interaction !
- Virtual exchange is a tool to increase interaction in distance education





UnaEuropa – Africa Working Group: Suggestions for practical actions

- Each university could have a contact person who could assist with recruiting moderators and disseminating virtual exchange call
 - It is important that we get the leaders of master's and doctoral programs involved in the network, as they have direct contact with students.
- It would be beneficial to discuss virtual exchange regularly in the Africa working group meetings so that we can hear the group's views and advice. Students participating in the virtual exchange come from different cultures and have different practices, which are important to consider during the planning and implementation phase.
- We also need suggestions for inspiring plenary speakers for the virtual exchange week. The speakers should represent the values and community of UnaEuropa. We are eager to hear the working group's suggestions and to utilize the group's opportunities to invite speakers.
- Perhaps the members of the working group could serve as UnaVEX ambassadors within their own networks. We can create a short promotional material for this purpose.


